

# NEW YEAR'S PROJECT MENU (NO GOOGLE SLIDES!)

<p><b><u>New Year's Food</u></b> Cook a traditional food for your country and bring it to class to share. Create a poster board explaining what it is, how it's made, and why it's a tradition.</p>	<p><b><u>International Cookbook</u></b> Create an international cookbook of recipes for your country's popular New Year foods, beverages, or snacks. Must include at least 4 recipes. Then, choose one food to make and bring it to class to share.</p>	<p><b><u>Travel Video</u></b> Make and edit a video pretending you are celebrating New Year's in your country. Video must be at least 2-3 minutes in length.</p>
<p><b><u>Brochure</u></b> Create a brochure about New Year's for a specific city in your country. Be sure to list all the celebrations happening, foods to eat, and traditions to take part in. All panels of the brochure must be completed.</p>	<p><b><u>Scrapbook</u></b> Create at least 4 pages of a scrapbook detailing pictures and captions about New Year's foods, celebrations, and traditions in your country.</p>	<p><b><u>Newspaper</u></b> Make a newspaper spread with 1 article about New Year's food, 1 article about New Year's celebrations/ events, and 1 article about New Year's traditions for a specific city in your country. Don't forget to add photos to your newspaper!</p>
<p><b><u>Tri-fold Poster</u></b> Make a tri-fold poster board about New Year's in your country. You must include a minimum of 2 pictures and 1 paragraph in each panel of your poster board.</p>	<p><b><u>Diorama</u></b> Create a diorama box depicting what a celebration might look like in your country. You must include a typed description of what is happening in your diorama. One full page, double spaced.</p>	<p><b><u>Have another idea?</u></b> Think you have a cool idea you want to create? Talk to me about your idea and I will let you know if I approve.</p>
